Mentor Coaching with Hannah.....

Hannah mentors intermediate and advanced coaches from various coach training programs and is the lead mentor coach at **Advantara® Global Executive Learning and Coach Training Institute**. Her Mentoring hours exceed 1500, and her executive coaching hours exceed 8,000 hours. As of early 2010, coaches mentored by Hannah have a one hundred percent success rate in becoming credentialed by the International Coach Federation.

Hannah's mentees have been extremely successful, publishing books (i.e, Doug Silsbee **The Mindful Coach** and **Presence-Based Coaching**), founding new coaching organizations (Foo See Luan, **APAC**), and introducing trainers to the world of coaching (Maureen Rabotin).

Her approach to mentor coaching:

Hannah works primarily with intercultural and global executive coaches to

- ❖ clarify their visions and missions
- ❖ design their practices around their lifestyles, visions and missions
- ❖ organize and market their practices worldwide
- ❖ extend their revenue income beyond coaching into products and passive revenue
- ❖ support them in being the best and most professional coaches they can be while living well as global citizens, helping to create a better human and business environment.
- ❖ balance their lives as human beings who inspire their clients

She meets with her mentees regularly according to an agreed upon schedule, usually four times a month for about fifty minutes. In between there may be quick calls, chats, or emails about a success or challenge. **Her minimum engagement is three months** but often last for a year or more, depending on the client's coach's needs, wishes and evolution.
